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






# perpetual, irrevocable **permissions**

### Open Educational Resources

Any kind of teaching materials – textbooks, syllabi, lesson plans, videos, readings, exams

### Open Educational Resources

Teaching, learning and research materials in any medium that reside in the public domain or have been released under an open license that permits no-cost access, use, adaptation and redistribution by others.

### 65%

of students decided against buying a required textbook because of cost

### 50%

of students said that cost of textbooks impacted how many and which classes they took

### 82%

of students felt they would do significantly better in a course if textbook was available for free

# increase **equity**

All students have access to high quality learning materials that have the most upto-date and relevant content because OER can be freely copied, modified and distributed to anyone.



Since 2012, OpenStax textbooks have saved 6.2 million students over US\$576M.

In 2019 alone, 2.2 million students are using OpenStax books and saving over US\$176M.






#### **Z-Degrees**

one-year or two-year postsecondary programs which are offered to students using openly licensed resources in place of proprietary textbooks

	Cost to Students	Permissions to Teachers and Students
Commercial Textbooks	Expensive	Restrictive
Library Resources	Free	Restrictive
Open Educational Resources	Free	5Rs



Publicly funded resources should be openly licensed resources.
