


PHASE 3:



ANALYSIS, REPORTING, DISSEMINATION



- Organize and analyze both primary and secondary sources of data to develop findings aligned with the research questions
- Use findings to develop conclusions and actionable recommendations
- Hold validation/consultation meetings with USAID and partners
- Write Final Report
- 1. Disseminate Final Report





DATA SYNTHESIS



Simultaneous to data analysis

No fixed process; can be structured team brainstorm

Broader interpretation of findings

More holistic, comprehensive, and systematic story

line

Foundation for headline conclusions

Simple, short, declarative sentences

Rooted in data/findings

Resonate with wider audience

Limited in number and prioritized

Accessible by busy readers
